

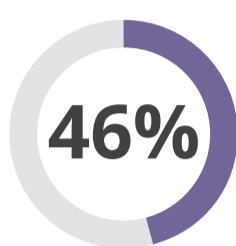

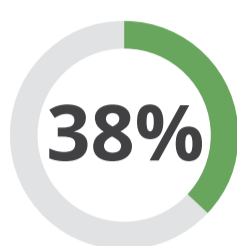


The EU referendum takes place on 23 June. With many polls indicating a close-run battle, we decided to ask our clients what they think.

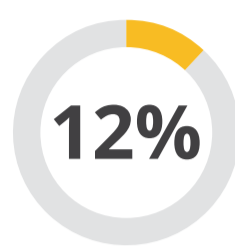
96% of contractors will be voting in the EU referendum on 23 June 2016

53% of contractors believe a Brexit will make it harder for them to use their skills abroad



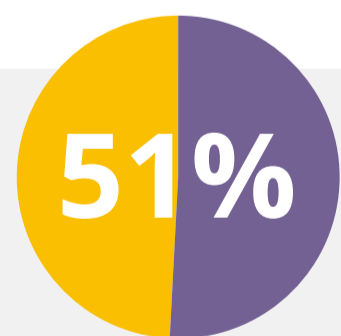
"Skills will still be required and companies will still have short term needs"



90% of contractors voting for Britain to leave the EU are not worried about the impact a Brexit would have on their own business



"If it does impact my business then I will have to evolve"



51% of all contractors that are undecided about their vote are worried about the impact a Brexit would have on their business

Whilst the gap between the Remain and Leave camps seems significant, the undecided 12% could swing the vote one way or the other. Regardless of the outcome, it's clear that contractors have great confidence in their skills and will remain in demand whether the UK is 'In' or 'Out'.
